

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 717, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE # I: NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: **American Council for Medicinally Active Plants, Inc.**

ARTICLE # II: PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE # III: SPECIFIC PURPOSE

The primary purpose of the **American Council for Medicinally Active Plants, Inc. (ACMAP)** is to promote and foster research, development, production, and conservation of medicinal, aromatic, and other bioactive plants useful to human health

The following activities are currently envisioned in order to accomplish stated goals of this council pertaining to basic and applied research, plant production, product development and evaluation, and marketing to provide better healthcare products for healthy life for both human and animal population.

The **American Council for Medicinally Active Plants, Inc** is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes, including for such purposes as making contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE # IV: MANNER OF ELECTION

The officers of the ACMAP shall be Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, and Member at Large. These officers shall serve as the ACMAP steering committee. Following the initial election of this council, the outgoing ACMAP officers' team shall convene the council meeting in order to select a slate of officers to be elected by the membership. Election will be by the majority vote of the membership. The membership of the board, and terms of service, shall be determined by provisions of the by-laws.

ARTICLE # VI: DISPERSEMENT OF EARNINGS

No part of the net earnings of ACMAP shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that ACMAP shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services set forth in Article # 3 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of ACMAP shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the ACMAP shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of **ACMAP**.

ARTICLE # VII: MANNER OF DISSOLUTION

If it becomes necessary for the dissolution of **ACMAP** due to some foreseen or unforeseen circumstances, the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes with the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Intellectual assets, such as copyright, trademark, etc., will be transferred to one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code that have the goals of promoting research, education and development of medicinally active plants that are consistent with the purposes of **ACMAP**.
